SERVICE OF PROCESS ON THE UNIVERSITY OF CALIFORNIA DAVIS

Legal notices involving university business require prompt attention. If a subpoena is received by mail or personal service, it should be accepted. The individual, and/or department, should *immediately* contact the <u>Office of Campus Counsel</u> for assistance.

Guidelines for properly served subpoenas

If the process server attempts to serve a subpoena at a location other than the department named on the subpoena:

- Direct the server to the correct department or,
- Direct them to the Office of the Campus Counsel

If the process server insists on leaving the subpoena

• Accept it and forward to the Office of Campus Counsel
